

Section 504 Child Find



What is Section 504 Child Find? A process of identifying, locating and referring every qualified disabled student residing within the Birmingham City School District (BCS) *including private* and *homeschooling* who may be eligible for Section 504 services.

What is Section 504? The Rehabilitation Act of 1973, commonly referred to as "Section 504," is a civil rights statue that prohibits discrimination/harassment on the basis of a disability in any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance.

What is Section 504 Purpose? Section 504 regulations require a school district to provide a "free appropriate public education" (FAPE) to each <u>qualified</u> student with a disability who is in the school's district's jurisdiction, regardless of the nature or severity of the disability.

What is the criteria for Section 504? Students with a *physical* or *mental impairment* that *substantially limit* a *major life activity* must be identified for individual inquiry. A referral is required to initiate the Section 504 process.
