Background/Discussion:	The final bill of \$1,653,388 for property insurance exceeded the board approved amount by \$193,468. The initial estimate was \$1,459,920. State of Alabama, Department of Finance for the Division of Risk Management cited inflation, coupled with the current market insurance for the significant increase in the FY24 premiums charged.
